

APPLICATION-HOW TO IDENTIFY THE ENEMY AT WORK IN OUR CIRCUMSTANCES FROM LESSON 31

- 1. Remember the counterfeit, Satan looks like the real deal, GOD. (2 Cor.11:14)
- 2. It is Satan, if we do anything that God tells us not to do in order to accomplish a certain goal. (Ep.4:17), (Prov.28:4)
- 3. It is Satan, if we ignore the promptings of the Holy Spirit not to take a certain course of action and do something we are uncomfortable with. (Ep.4:30)
- 4. It is Satan, if we seek to please man rather than please God. (Pro.29:25)

APPLICATION - QUIET

- 1. Our daily quiet time should be just that, daily and quiet. God will not compete with (TV, music, phones, etc.) distractions of any kind. (1 Sam.3:8-10)
- 2. Teach each of your family members to respect your quiet time. (Matt.4:4)
- 3. Incorporate into each child's day a quiet time of their own where they can read scripture and pray. Discuss what they learned from God during this time.
- 4. Be comfortable with silence. (Ps.62:1-2,5-8)
