DAVID : Lesson 70:

An important aspect of Scripture is that it gives us the total account, from birth to death, of significant people. For example, we knew Samuel before his birth. We first met David when he was a young shepherd boy caring for his father's flocks. We know David was born in Bethlehem Ephrathah. We know his father was Jesse and that David was the youngest of eight sons. We also know that before David was conceived, God had picked him to become Israel's second king. We begin today in 1 Samuel 16.
