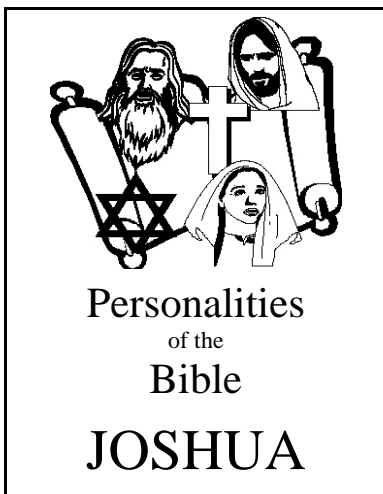

APPLICATIONS FROM LESSON 17

SIN TENDENCIES BEING TRANSMITTED TO EACH OF US FROM FAMILY GENERATIONS.

Can you identify these in your family?

1. Are you aware of any recurring sin throughout the generations among family members?
2. That sin will be an area of special temptation for you and future generations.
3. Take special precaution to avoid those sins (1 Corinthians 10:13)
4. Make no provision for the flesh. (Romans 13:14)
5. Teach your children
6. Memorize Romans 12:1-2. Renew our minds everyday. Honor God with your body (1 Corin.6:18-20)
7. Expect Satan to try and defeat you in these inherited predispositions.

Satan wants to destroy us. He has set the world standards and he wants us to self-destruct.

APPLICATIONS CONCERNING FEAR

FEAR FROM SATAN:

1. Will encourage you to act immediately based on your own understanding or others advice without waiting upon God and prayer.
2. Will cause you to doubt God, doubt His word, His control over your life and situation, and His power and love.

God will allow his servants to experience fear as we serve Him. Fear is a fiery dart from Satan to prevent us from acting in faith. (Reject the dart!)

Don't allow fear to prevent you from doing what God wants you to do.

The Holy Spirit warns us of danger by causing us to be uncomfortable and to discern the red flags and not having peace from taking certain actions. (No peace, no action). Take every decision to God.
