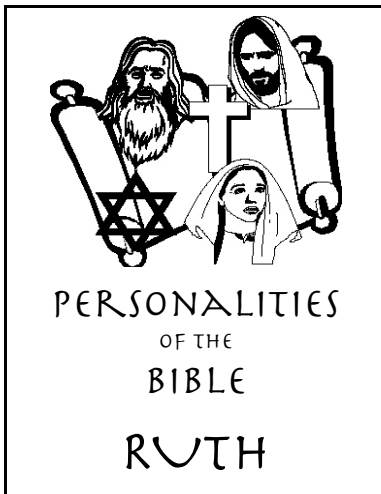

APPLICATION—GOD’S UNCHANGING STANDARD

Serve God	For the LORD loves the just and will not forsake his faithful ones.	Ps 37:28
Delight God	If the LORD delights in a man's way, he makes his steps firm; though he stumble, he will not fall, for the LORD upholds him with his hand.	Ps 37:23-24
Praise God	I waited patiently for the LORD; he turned to me and heard my cry. He lifted me out of the slimy pit, out of the mud and mire; he set my feet on a rock and gave me a firm place to stand. Witness God's goodness	Finally, brothers, whatever is true, whatever is noble, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable—if anything is excellent or praiseworthy —think about such things.	Phil 4:8
