


LESSON 28:

APPLICATIONS-READY AND ABLE Lesson 28

- 1. God gives each of this children important work to do for Him (Matt 28:18-20), (Eph. 2:10)
- God fully equips each child to successfully complete the work by giving them: A. Indwelling Holy Spirit (Eph.1:13-14), (2Corin. 3:1-6)
 - B. The completed Bible taught to us by the Holy Spirit (2 Tim. 3:16-17)
 - C. Spiritual gifts given to us by the Holy Spirit after we were saved (1 Cor. <u>12</u>), (Eph. 4:11-12), (Rom.12:6-8)
- 3. There is a season of training (months to years) before being sent. (1Tim. 3:6), (Gal. 1:11-24)
- 4. Our goal is to finish the work God has given us to do. (John 17:4), (2 Tim. 4:6-7)
- 5. We will receive eternal rewards for doing the work. (2Tim 4:8), (1 Cor. 3:10-15)
