


#### LESSON 31:



### APPLICATIONS FROM LESSON 31

#### HOW TO PRAY FOR SINFUL LOVED ONES

- 1. Ask God to lead them to genuine repentance and or salvation. (1 Sam. 12:25)
- 2. Ask God to cause them to become miserable and to get no pleasure in their sin. Do not pray for them to get happy. (Rom. 6:23) (John 3:19-21)
- 3. Ask God to cause all evil influences to lose interest in them and leave them. (1 Corin. 15:33)
- 4. Ask God to cause them to read the scriptures and have it become the most interesting book they ever read. (Heb. 4:12), (Rom.12:2)
- 5. Ask God to tear down the strongholds that Satan has held them captive, to do His will. (2 Tim. 2:25-26).
- 6. Pray without ceasing for them. (1 Thess.5:17)
